1. Vente-unique.com's Commitments

We respect the privacy of our users and ensure that all information collected which allows for their identification is treated as confidential information. In accordance with this, we are committed to:

- To strictly comply with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on personal data protection (**GDPR**), and the **Data Protection Act 2018**;
- To comply with the **Data Protection Acts 1988 and 2003**;
- To strictly comply with the **European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Privacy and Electronic Communications) Regulations 2011**;
- To implement all appropriate measures regarding the provision of information and the collection of your consent for the placement of cookies on your device.

2. Privacy Policy Relative to Personal Data

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to outline to the User the reasons why personal data is collected by Vente-unique.com, how it is used, and the options available to the User to object to such use. Any data collected is used strictly within the limits permitted by law. Vente-unique.com pays particular attention to the protection of the User's personal information and undertakes to comply with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on personal data protection (hereinafter the "**GDPR**").

Preliminary Definitions

The terms mentioned below have the following meaning in this Privacy Policy:

- "**Customer**": refers to any person who accesses the Site, is registered, and places an order on the Site.
- "**Data**" or "**Personal Data**": refers to personal data undergoing Processing under this Privacy Policy, as defined in Article 4(1) of the GDPR.
- "**General Data Protection Regulation**" or "**GDPR**": refers to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the Processing of Personal Data and on the free movement of such Data.
- "**Data Controller**": refers to the person who determines the means and purposes of the Processing in accordance with Article 4(7) of the GDPR and Section 6 of the Data Protection Act 2018.
- "**Site**": refers to the Vente-unique.com website accessible at the following address: [Vente-unique.ie](https://vente-unique.com).
- "**Processor**": refers to the natural or legal person, public authority, agency, or other

body which Processes Personal Data on behalf of and according to the instructions of the Data Controller in accordance with Article 4(8) of the GDPR.

- **"Processing/Process"**: refers to any of the operations referred to in Article 4(2) of the GDPR, performed on Personal Data within the framework of the execution of this Privacy Policy.
- **"User"**: refers to any person who accesses and browses the Site, whether they are a Customer or a casual internet user.

Who is Responsible for Protecting Your Data?

The Data Controller of your Data is the company Vente-unique.com (hereinafter "**Vente-unique.com**"), a public limited company with a Board of Directors and a share capital of 97.800,29€, registered with the Bobigny Trade and Companies Register (R.C.S.) under number 484 922 778, with its registered office located at 9 Rue Jacquard - 93310 Le Pré-Saint-Gervais, France.

Further Information Regarding the Data Protection Officer:

The mission of the Data Protection Officer is to inform, advise, and monitor the compliance of Vente-unique.com in the performance of its data processing operations.

In accordance with data protection regulations, the DPO shall act as the primary point of contact:

- For Data Subjects: regarding any matter relating to the processing of data carried out by Vente-unique.com or the exercise of your statutory rights;
- For Supervisory Authorities: specifically, the CNIL in France and the **Data Protection Commission (DPC)** in Ireland, as part of their duty to cooperate. The DPO may also contact these authorities to seek an opinion or prior consultation on any matters concerning the protection of personal data;
- For other DPOs: appointed by third-party Data Processors or participating Data Controllers.

How Do We Collect Your Data?

As a general principle, all Data concerning the User is collected directly from the User—for instance, during registration on the Site, through correspondence with Vente-unique.com, when placing an order, creating an account, requesting contact or information, subscribing to the Newsletter, or while browsing the Site.

Data relating to your browsing activity on the Site may be used to identify your needs and interests and to tailor our commercial and advertising offers accordingly.

In the event of a Newsletter subscription, the User has the option to opt out of marketing communications in every email or SMS. What Data is Collected?

Requested data marked with an asterisk is mandatory for the proper processing of the order or the service requested by the User. The provision of this data is a requirement for entering into a contract. If the User wishes to place an order or requests a service, they are obliged to provide it. Failure to do so will mean Vente-unique.com will be unable to carry out the order or the service requested by the User.

Customers have the option to modify their Data or close their account at any time.

Who Has Access to My Data?

The Data collected by the Site is intended for Vente-unique.com and the entities it controls, that control it, or that are under common control with it (control being understood within the meaning of relevant company law) for the purposes of performing the service (e.g., ordering or delivery). The Site may transfer Data to its subsidiaries and affiliates, or to third parties in the event of a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy, dissolution, reorganisation, or any other similar operation.

Data collected by the Site may be transferred to third-party **Processors** for the purposes of performing the service. In this event, these third-party Processors act on behalf of Vente-unique.com and undertake to comply with the instructions of Vente-unique.com as well as the provisions of this Privacy Policy.

These third-party Processors use and process the Data to ensure the proper performance of the service requested by the User. For example: information relating to the Customer's postal address is shared to allow third-party delivery service providers to complete the delivery of the order to the Customer's home.

The third-party Processors and partners engaged by Vente-unique.com have committed to complying with the provisions of the **GDPR**. The Site will implement the necessary security measures and ensure that the third parties it engages comply with the personal data rules set out by the said Regulation.

The Site may transmit and share User Data:

- **With third-party Processors** acting on behalf of Vente-unique.com to enable the

proper performance of the service requested by the User;

- **Where Vente-unique.com has received the User's express consent** to transfer the Data to a third-party partner (e.g., advertisers), such as by ticking a box allowing Vente-unique.com to share Data with third-party partners;
- **Following a summons or lawful request** issued by a competent authority to Vente-unique.com to produce said Data;
- **In the event of suspicion by the Site** regarding fraud, security issues, or technical problems, Vente-unique.com may share Data with the relevant authorities;

Is My Data Transferred Outside the European Union?

Data is transferred to the following countries: France, the United Kingdom (solely regarding payment information), and Tunisia.

When Data is transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA), Vente-unique.com implements appropriate safeguards, specifically by using the **European Union Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs)**, to ensure an identical level of protection for User Data. How Long Is My Data Kept For?

We retain your Data only for as long as necessary for the purposes pursued, as described below:

Connection logs and action history are kept for a period not exceeding six (6) months. For card payments, in accordance with applicable financial regulations, data may be kept for evidentiary purposes in the event of a transaction dispute or claim, in intermediate archives, for thirteen (13) months following the debit date (extended to 15 months for deferred debit cards). PAN (Primary Account Number) and CVV/CVC codes are not stored.
Invoice Management	Issued invoices and accounting data are retained for ten (10) years from the date of issue.
Order Dispatch	For the duration of the contractual relationship, followed by storage in intermediate archiving for the applicable statute of limitations (five (5) years for evidentiary purposes).
Order Delivery	For the duration of the contractual relationship,

Newsletter / Commercial Offers	Data is retained until consent is withdrawn (unsubscribing via the provided link) or, where applicable, for the duration of the contractual relationship, followed by intermediate archiving for three (3) years after the end of the relationship or three (3) years after the last contact with Vente-unique.com.
Loyalty Programme	For the duration necessary for processing and for a period of five (5) years after the last contact from you, for evidentiary purposes.

Management of Rights Requests (GDPR & Data Protection Act 2018)	Personal Data relating to the management of rights requests is kept for the time necessary to process the request, then stored in intermediate archiving for the applicable statutory limitation period, namely six (6) years.

What Are Your Rights Under the GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018, and How Can You Exercise Them?

In accordance with applicable regulations, every User has the following rights:

- **Right of Access** (Article 15 GDPR): To obtain confirmation as to whether or not your personal data is being processed and to receive a copy of that data.
- **Right to Rectification** (Article 16 GDPR): To have inaccurate personal data rectified or completed.
- **Right to Erasure / Right to be Forgotten** (Article 17 GDPR): To have your personal data deleted when it is no longer necessary, or when you withdraw consent.
- **Right to Withdraw Consent** (Article 13-2 c & d GDPR): To withdraw your consent at any time where the processing is based on consent.

- **Right to Restriction of Processing** (Article 18 GDPR): To "pause" the use of your data in specific circumstances.
 - **Right to Data Portability** (Article 20 GDPR): To receive your data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format for transfer to another service.
 - **Right to Object** (Article 21 GDPR): To object to the processing of your data, particularly for direct marketing purposes.
